We contribute our time, expertise, and efforts to help others and advance our shared conservation mission.

As a professional organization, we seek to strike a balance between encouraging open networking and maintaining professional boundaries. The focus is to encourage active participation, inclusivity, and productive collaboration.

❖ Core Values and Foundations

- **Integrity – We value truth, honesty, and ethical conduct.**
- **Respect – We treat all colleagues and participants with dignity and reject harassment and discrimination.**
- **Empathy – We demonstrate awareness of others' perspectives, circumstances, and experiences.**
- **Civility – We maintain and foster courteous and respectful interactions in a safe space, particularly during disagreement.**

❖ Engagement and Communication

- **Active Listening – We listen to understand and engage with the speaker's perspective.**
- **Welcoming Engagement – We foster an environment where all participants feel welcomed, respected, and comfortable contributing, and encourage broad participation from individuals with varied backgrounds, experiences, and viewpoints.**
- **Constructive Dialogue – We debate or challenge ideas respectfully and with open minds while valuing the people behind them.**
- **Collaboration – We actively share knowledge, experiences, and lessons learned.**

❖ Professional Conduct and Responsibility

- **Professionalism** – We demonstrate reliability, preparedness, accountability, and appropriate conduct.
- **Accountability** – We take ownership of our actions, decisions, commitments, and the impact of our work on others and our organization.
- **Dependability** – We follow through on commitments and support organizational goals.
- **Stewardship** – We responsibly care for our community, resources and the trust placed in us.

- **Curiosity** – We approach new ideas and challenges with openness and a desire to learn and grow
